

## English Language Test Exemptions

The following applicants **may** be considered for admission to graduate study without submitting English language test scores (e.g., IELTS, TOEFL, PTE).

1. Those who hold a degree in which the language of instruction was English, provided English is the official language of the country in which the university is located OR the institution is accredited by a U.S. regional accrediting agency.
2. Citizens of the following countries:
